All singers need to attend a minimum 80% of rehearsals, including the final Wednesday rehearsal, for a concert programme in order to sing in the concert, unless they otherwise have the Conductor's permission to do so.

If you are unable to perform at any concert, please inform the Concert Secretary (Corinna Gregory: <u>birminghambachconcerts@yahoo.com</u>) at the earliest opportunity.
